STUDENT SCHOLARSHIP OF EXCELLENCE OF MNB INVITATION FOR APPLICATIONS

For students of Hungarian and English language programmes: International Economy and Business; Finance; or Enterprise Development MSc Degree Programmes at the Faculty of Economics and Business Administration of the University of Szeged

Magyar Nemzeti Bank, the Central Bank of Hungary (hereinafter referred to as 'MNB'), without prejudice to its primary objective and further to its primary tasks, in order to promote the implementation of social objectives, in line with its interests and specific features, has formed its funding policy as a part of its external relationships based on the Statutes and the Corporate Social Responsibility Strategy of MNB approved by the Executive Board of MNB. Pursuant to Section 170 (3) a) of Act CXXXIX of 2013 on the Magyar Nemzeti Bank, MNB's revenues from fines may be used for promoting and supporting the training of specialists in economics and finances.

In agreement with its Corporate Social Responsibility Strategy, MNB is actively engaged in value creation in economics, whereby it funds the "Student Scholarship of Excellence of MNB." Awarded applicants may be granted the amount of scholarship under "Student Scholarship of Excellence of MNB" in monthly instalment payments of HUF 50,000 due for a period of 10 months (from September to June) provided that the student meets the eligibility criteria of the scholarship.

The announcement of the Invitation for Applications for the scholarship, the decision process of awarding the scholarship and its payment will be performed in accordance with the contract signed between the SZTE and MNB, and the Code on the fees and charges payable by the students of the University of Szeged and the forms of support available to them, in conformity with the special regulations for the scholarship.

The scholarship will be awarded to 4 students.

Terms and conditions of application:

Terms of eligibility for the scholarship:

- a) The applicant is a full-time, active MSc student in a state-funded or fee-paying form of education at the Faculty of Economics and Business Administration of the University of Szeged (hereinafter referred to as 'SZTE') studying International Economy and Business; Finance; or Enterprise Development MSc.
- b) The applicant is not a Stipendium Hungaricum scholarship holder.
- c) The applicant has registered to, at least, two semesters of the degree study programme to be aided by the scholarship, and has collected, at least, 54 credit points in the previous two subsequent, active semesters. (MNB may give exemption under completing 54 credits, if the student, besides achieving excellent academic results, has no opportunity to take this much credit because in previous years the student had earned more credits than recommended by the curriculum.)

- d) The applicant has completed, pro rata temporis, minimum 90% of the total number of credit points as set forth in the Sample Curriculum of the major concerned.
- e) In the previous two subsequent, finished, active semesters, the weighted credit index of the courses the applicant registered for was better than 4.00 in both semesters, and the applicant participated in scientific or other professional activities as well.
- f) The applicant agrees to personally attend the scholarship award conference organized by the MNB.
- g) The applicant fills and submits the data protection form of the MNB together with the application.

Furthermore, all students who were/will be participating in a mobility programme within the framework of a mobility agreement (e.g. Erasmus+, CEEPUS, CAMPUS Mundi or institutional bilateral agreements), were/will be completing partial training or in-company internship abroad in the two preceding active semesters or during the payment period of the scholarship that form the basis of the calculation of points shall also be regarded as eligible applicants for the scholarship.

Evaluation criteria:

The Jury Committee will apply the following distribution criteria in the evaluation process: academic performance (50%); scientific activities, such as publications, scientific student conference papers, participations in international and national competitions and special college activities (40%); and public functions and community activities (10%).

A Committee made up of the representatives of SZTE will be authorised to evaluate the applications.

Terms and conditions of eligibility for the scholarship:

- The scholarship awarded for the Academic Year of 2023/2024 may be paid exclusively in the academic year of 2023/2024 by SZTE. The payment of the scholarship cannot be restructured for later than the academic year following the academic year of application.
- If, in line with the timeframe of the training programme, a student finishes her/his studies in an odd semester (i.e. the First or Autumn Semester of the Academic Year of 2023/2024), and the same institution offers a master's degree programme that is also aided by the scholarship programme, the student shall remain eligible for the scholarship provided that, following a successful entrance examination, s/he continues her/his studies in the commencing semester in one of the master's degree training programmes of the same higher education institution that is also aided by the scholarship programme.
- In the event of termination or suspension of student status, further payment of the scholarship shall be terminated as well.

Documents to be attached with the Application Form:

- The student's statement that s/he will comply with the terms and conditions of the Invitation for Applications, with special reference to the provisions on the termination of further payment of the scholarship.
- The student's statement that enables the Jury Committee members, the representatives of MNB and the administrators of the application process to manage her/his personal details.
- The student's statement that, in the event of being awarded, s/he agrees that her/his personal details (especially his/her name and major) be used in the communication of SZTE and MNB, images and/or sound recordings be taken of her/him, and further agrees that these data be made public through the communication of SZTE and MNB.
- The student's statement that she/he shall be available for media purposes regarding the application and the scholarship.
- The student's statement of consent to consult in advance with the appointed representative of SZTE in connection with any media inquiries about the application and the scholarship.

Until a decision is made, the submitted applications shall be archived at SZTE. Pursuant to the Data Handling Policy of the University of Szeged, the applications shall be destroyed after the communication of the results.

All submitted applications will be archived through the electronic system of the SZTE. After the announcement of the results the application documents shall be deleted in accordance with the Privacy Policy of the SZTE in the following way:

- the application documents of non-winners shall be deleted 5 years after the announcement of the results in case of possible legal disputes and their easier resolution,
- the application documents of scholarship winners shall be deleted 8 years after the closure of the application period in accordance with Act C of 2000 on accounting for the reason of financial accountability.

The applicants shall be informed electronically by SZTE about the results of the Evaluation of Applications.

It is not possible to submit any corrections after the deadline has passed.

- Application Form and Statements;
