Instruction for presentation and discussion

Instruction for presentations:

Official language of the workshop is English, that is why presentation and slides also should be in English. Participants give presentations based on the written paper, which should be no longer than **15 minutes**, leaving 15 minutes for discussion.

Instruction for discussion (for junior discussants):

Please carefully read the full paper selected for you before the PhD workshop and formulate your opinion on the paper. At the PhD workshop each of the junior discussants has **3-5 minutes** to present his/her opinion on the selected paper and the presentation after the presentation.

Each paper is assigned to a junior discussant (PhD student) who has his/her own presentation in the same session. **Order of discussions in the session**: the last presenter of the particular session gives his/her opinion on the paper and presentation of the first presenter, the first presenter gives his/her opinion on the paper and presentation of the second presenter and finally, the second presenter gives his/her opinion on the paper and presentation of the third presenter.

During the 3-5 minutes, junior discussants should be able to emphasize the most important thoughts on the papers and presentations e.g. related to the research question, the structure of the paper, methodology, the consistency of the presentation and the full paper.

Each junior discussant must ask a question or questions related to the paper and the presentation! The junior discussions will be followed by the senior discussions by the chairs and vice-chair.

Please be very strict in terms of time managements, each presenters during the workshop should have an equal amount of time.

According to the evaluation of the session chairs, some of the papers presented at the PhD Workshop will be selected for publication in a refereed workshop proceeding under ISBN number.
